**From Father Mike Tix . . .**

One of the discussion points coming of our first Church Chat session was communication. In the past, the primary means of communication was the Sunday church bulletin, which remains a valued source of information. With the rise of email and social media come new opportunities for timely announcements on the one-hand, to sharing either pictures of activity or thoughts for the day to consider. It has been said that if a church – or any other organization for that matter – is not on social media, then in the minds of some generations, the church does not exist. Social media provides the opportunity to plan seeds of faith, and opportunities of evangelization that are important in our fast-paced world of today.

Currently St. John’s Church, St. John’s School, and St. Mary’s Church all face Facebook sites. If you have not signed up to “Follow” these, I encourage you to do so today. Volunteers administer each of these Facebook sites. I want to thank this opportunity to thank these volunteers for sharing their time and talent in this way that helps all of us to stay better connected. At this point, we do not have an official Facebook site for St. Mathias. It would be nice to have one so that each of the three parishes has a site and can share timely information. If you are interested in helping to start a Facebook site for St. Mathias, please contact me.

All of the three parishes and St. John’s School has a website. It would be good to do a review of the parish sites to consider how they are meeting current and future needs. One of the comments that came up at the Chat sessions was wouldn’t it be nice if each parish could do new parishioner registration online. We did this when I was at St. John’s in Savage and it was fantastic. If you have some knowledge and experience in websites, and want to be a part of a review that maximizes the opportunities of using websites for outreach, please contact me.

As a side note, in terms of the Sunday bulletin, while bulletins are always available after Mass, that you are welcome and encouraged to have the bulletin emailed directly to you each week, so that if you are away, you are aware of current parish happenings and events. For more information of how to sign-up to have the weekly bulletin emailed to you, go to any one of the three parish websites, and under “bulletin” you can subscribe to this service.

Another Chat session idea was to do a weekly email burst for the three parishes and school that would not replace the Sunday bulletin, but instead serve as another means of outreach and greater communication. These weekly email burst are successful and happening at many parishes today. This question could be a part of not only a review of parish websites, but developing a comprehensive communication plan to serve the three parishes and school.

It’s good for us to consider the possibility that email and social media present in inviting people to come to know and experience the gift of God’s love in our three parishes and school.

No one was around or in church. I'm afraid this is asking for trouble. As a reminder, the church is unlocked by 8:00AM Mon-Thu and Saturday. It's opened earlier for Friday and Sunday Mass. The church is locked up around 5:00PM each day. I'm happy to continue doing so, but if we have additional issues we may be forced to re-think this.
